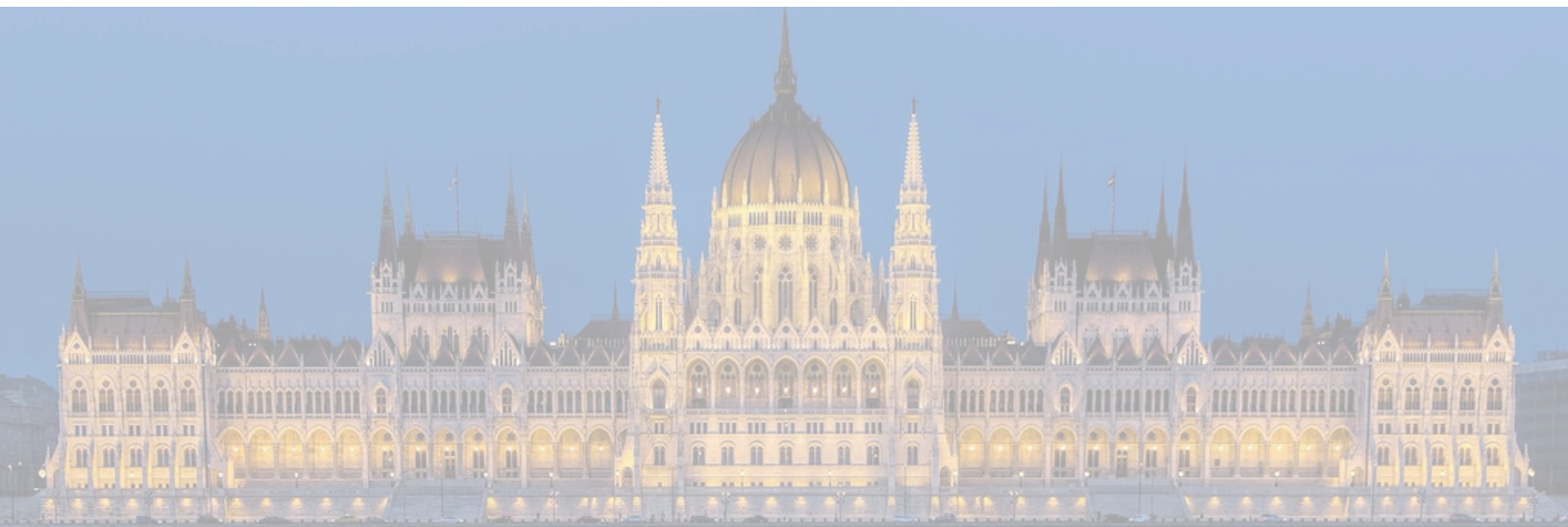
DAY 9 - RETURN FLIGHTS

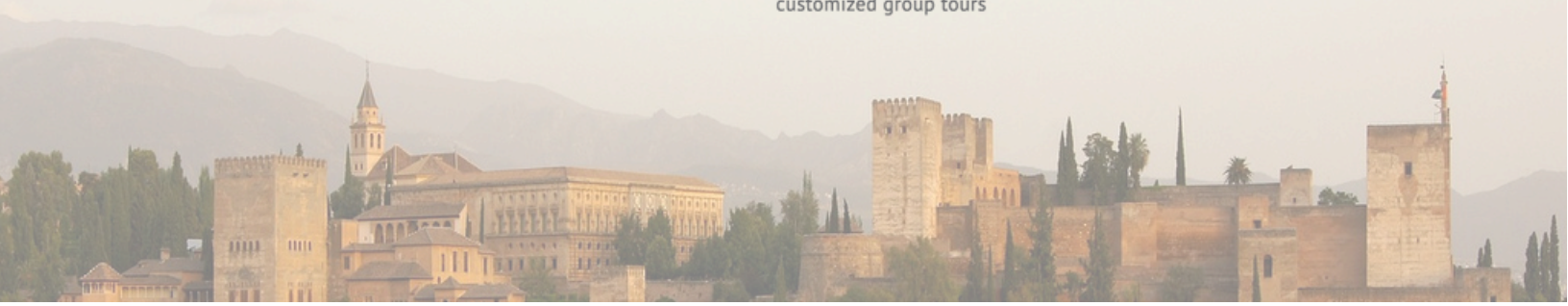
