DAY 1 - DEPARTURE FLIGHTS

Departure flights from the USA take you to London, UK, where your European history tour begins. This vibrant city brims with iconic landmarks and history to explore and learn from.

DAY 2 - ARRIVE IN LONDON

Arrive in London, where your Tour Manager will meet you upon landing. London, one of the world's great melting pots, has a unique character all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. On your afternoon Tour Manager led walking tour we get to admire architectural marvels like St. Paul's Cathedral, by Sir Christopher Wren. Explore the area of Piccadilly Circus, Trafalgar Square and more! Enjoy a well-deserved welcome dinner at night.

DAY 3 - LONDON SIGHTSEEING

Start your day with a guided sightseeing tour with your Blue Badge guide, with stops to see such greats as Buckingham Palace, St. Paul's Cathedral, and an included entrance to Westminster Abbey, the burial place of many famous authors and poets. In addition to burials, the Abbey has served as a site for royal coronations and 17 royal weddings—including Prince William and Duchess Kate. Enjoy dinner at night.



DAY 4 - FULL DAY EXCURSION

We have a jam-packed, captivating day starting early in the morning from London. Our excursion begins with the ancient mystery of Stonehenge, a 5,000-year-old UNESCO World Heritage Site steeped in history and wonder. Next, we journey to Oxford, the "City of Dreaming Spires," renowned for its historic university, stunning architecture, and literary heritage. Enjoy a guided visit to a prestigious Oxford college, uncovering centuries of academic brilliance. Dinner together at night.

DAY 5 - TOWER OF LONDON

This morning, visit the Tower of London, a historic fortress, royal palace, and infamous prison. Marvel at the crown jewels, spot the iconic "Beefeaters," and count the ravens—legend says England will fall if fewer than six remain. Currently, nine ravens reside there. Spend your afternoon exploring the city with chaperoned options before reuniting with the group for dinner, wrapping up a day steeped in history and vibrant urban discovery.

DAY 6 - EDINBURGH CASTLE

Travel from London to Edinburgh by train through the picturesque English countryside. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided tour featuring entrance to Edinburgh Castle, one of Europe's oldest fortifications. Once home to royals like Mary, Queen of Scots, this medieval fortress brims with history, secrets, and ghostly tales. Admire panoramic city views from Castle Hill, then explore Edinburgh at your leisure this afternoon before rejoining the group for a delightful evening dinner.



DAY 7 - TROSSACHS PARK

After breakfast, embark on a full-day excursion to Trossachs National Park and the Scottish Highlands, famed for their stunning landscapes and historic significance. Visit the Wallace Monument, commemorating William Wallace's victory at the Battle of Stirling Bridge, and explore Stirling Castle, birthplace of Mary, Queen of Scots and James VI and I. Conclude your journey with a stop at the Kelpies before returning south to Edinburgh for dinner, ending a memorable day.

DAY 8 - HOLYROOD PALACE

Begin your day with a visit to Holyrood Palace, steeped in royal history and dramatic British events. Spend your afternoon free time exploring Edinburgh, ticking off your Scottish bucket list. Consider the National Museum of Scotland or stroll through Old Town's gothic landmarks, cobblestone streets, and the iconic Royal Mile. Admire the city's historic architecture at every turn before concluding your adventure with a memorable farewell dinner in the evening.

DAY 10 - RETURN FLIGHT

All good things must come to an end, and sadly, so must this tour. After breakfast, we transfer to the airport for your return flight, reflecting on the unforgettable experiences and memories made during your incredible journey. Safe travels and we hope to welcome you back again soon!






- Above rates may have supplement added depending on your departure airport hub and travel season.

- Supplements and optional extras can be added.






ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
