Join this tour through Northern and Central France, from Normandy's historic shores to the elegant boulevards of Paris. After arriving in France, we travel west to Caen, the lively capital of Normandy. Discover the powerful history of the D-Day beaches, wander the winding streets of Mont-Saint-Michel crowned by its iconic abbey, and soak in the maritime charm of the walled city of Saint-Malo.

From Saint-Malo, the journey continues south to the Loire Valley, where we spend two nights surrounded by fairy-tale châteaux, rolling vineyards, and the refined French countryside. We then travel onward to Paris, the heart of French art and culture. Enjoy four days exploring the Eiffel Tower, the Louvre, and the artistic streets of Montmartre.

Day 3

Normandy D-Day



Travel through Normandy to explore Pointe du Hoc, Omaha Beach, Arromanches, and the American Cemetery, then return Caen in the evening.

Normandy D-Day

Begin the day with a visit to the D-Day Museum, an impressive and deeply moving showcase of World War II history and the pivotal events of the Normandy landings. Journey along the scenic Normandy coast, pausing at Arromanches, a key site of the Allied invasion, where you will have free time to explore the historic port and enjoy a leisurely lunch. Pay your respects at the American Cemetery in Colleville-sur-Mer, the final resting place of over 9,000 soldiers who gave their lives during the Battle of Normandy.

Walk along the sands of Omaha Beach, retracing the courageous steps of the American forces on D-Day, and visit Pointe du Hoc, where a striking monument honors the heroism of the 2nd Ranger Battalion. Absorb the dramatic landscapes and stories of bravery before returning to Caen in the evening, where a welcoming dinner awaits to reflect on a day steeped in history.
