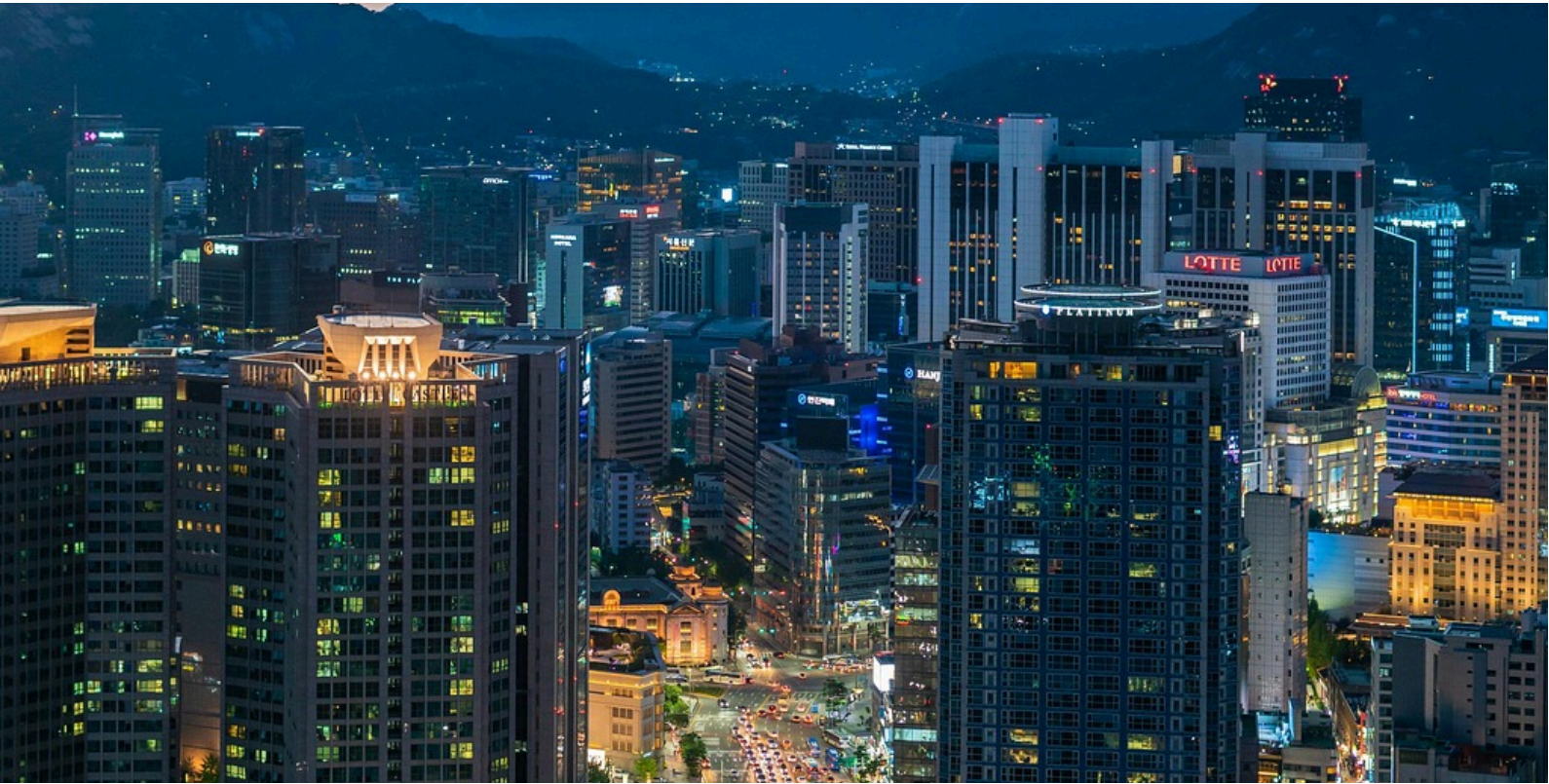

Day 7 Temple & Beaches	Visit Haedong Yonggungsa Temple and Zodiac Park, relax at Haeundae Beach, and enjoy a walk along Gwangalli Beach.
Day 8 Seokguram Grotto Buddha	Travel to Gyeongju with a stop at Tongdosa Temple, then visit Gyeongju National Park, Bulguksa Temple, and Seokguram Grotto.
Day 9 Silla Kingdom	Explore Gyeongju National Museum, the Tomb of King Michu, and Donggung Palace & Wolji Pond.
Day 10 Korea War Memorial	Return to Seoul by high-speed train and visit the War Memorial of Korea before checking in at hotel in Seoul.

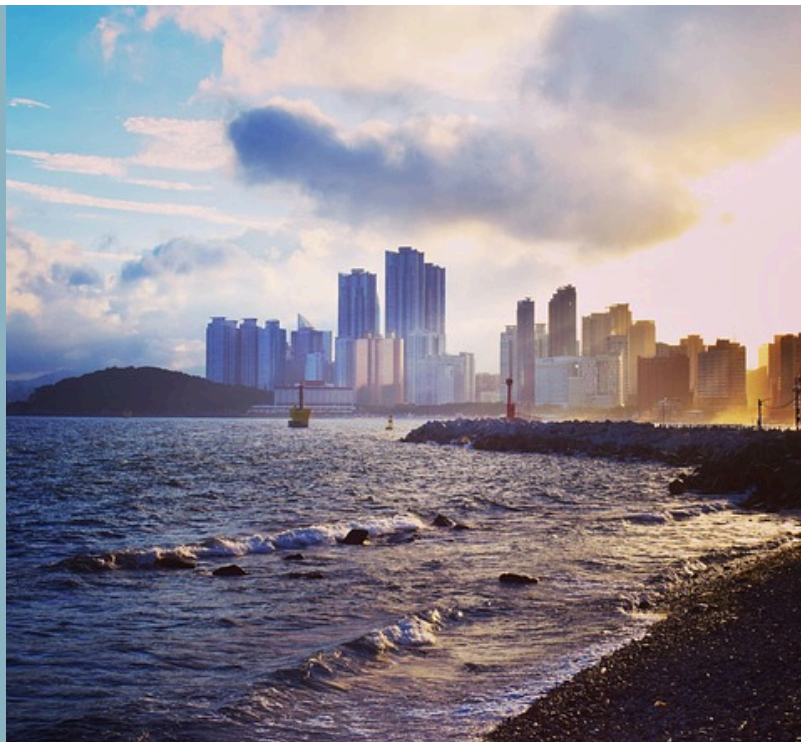
