Travel to Cusco and enjoy a full day of sightseeing. Dinner in Cusco at night.

Cusco Sightseeing

Morning transfer to the airport to take a flight to Cusco. Arrival to Cusco around midday and check in at central hotel. After included lunch, the group will have a city tour starting in the city center visiting the Cathedral and Corikancha, and then heading to 4 main archaeological sites around Cusco. Start at the Sacsayhuamán fortress, one of the emblematic Inca fortress. From there you will continue to Qenqo, a circular amphitheater mainly for religious purposes. Onwards to Puka Pukara, which means "red fortress", was an architectural complex presumably used for military purposes. We will end our tour with a visit to Tambomachay, also known as El Baño del Inca, or the Bath of the Inca. Dinner at night in Cusco.

Here, you'll have time to explore the vibrant craft market, enjoy a leisurely lunch, and tour the impressive archaeological site, taking in its terraces, temples, and panoramic views.

From Pisac, we journey to Ollantaytambo, a charming town historically used to host delegations traveling long distances. Wander its cobbled streets, admire the well-preserved Incan architecture, and soak in the town's unique atmosphere. At the end of the day's excursion, transfer to your hotel in the Sacred Valley, where you'll enjoy dinner and unwind, surrounded by the beauty of the Andes.

Machu Picchu



Travel by Vista Dome train to Aguas Caliente and visit Machu Picchu with local guide.

Machu Picchu

Travel to Aguas Calientes on the scenic Vista Dome train from the Sacred Valley, enjoying sweeping views of the Andes along the 2-hour journey. From the train station, a short bus ride brings you to Machu Picchu, a masterpiece of engineering and architecture that served as a sanctuary and retreat for the Inca ruler Pachacuti. Known as the "Old Mountain," Machu Picchu is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the New7Wonders of the World.

After exploring the citadel, return to Aguas Calientes for lunch at Inkaterra. In the afternoon, board the Vista Dome train back to Ollantaytambo and transfer to your hotel in the Sacred Valley, where you'll enjoy dinner and an overnight stay surrounded by the breathtaking Andean scenery.
